

Call for Poster Abstracts

2017 AAHRPP Conference:

Evolving, Adapting, and Thriving in the New Research Environment

AAHRPP is now accepting abstracts from accredited organizations for poster presentations at the 2017 Annual AAHRPP Conference which will be held May 9-11 in Detroit, Michigan.

This call for abstracts is focused on innovative practices for Human Research Protections Programs (HRPP) related to the theme of the conference – “Evolving, Adapting, and Thriving in the New Research Environment”. The innovative practice may relate to any aspect of human research protection, but preference will be given to topics related to the themes of the conference, such as the changing landscape of research oversight, innovations in research design, single IRB review, and big data, genomic research and privacy. The Poster Session will provide presenting authors a forum to showcase their innovative practices and the opportunity to review the information and talk with presenters. All presenters are asked to include any related metrics that they use such as forms, checklists, and templates.

The deadline for submitting an abstract is ***February 8, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. ET.***

Authors will be notified by ***February 13, 2017*** if their abstract is accepted for presentation.

Instructions for preparing the poster will be provided at that time.

Presenters are required to register and pay the registration fee.
